## NOTICE OF REGATTA

## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the current IRC Rules, the current PHRF Regulations as administered by the YRA of LIS and Level or One-Design Class rules.
- 1.2 Boats shall observe the Minimum Equipment Recommendations of YRA of LIS, Race Category C.
- 1.3 Each boat shall carry a radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channel 73.
- 1.4 Sections A, B and D of Appendix T will apply as changed by the sailing instructions.

## 2 ENTRIES

- 2.1 Eligible boats may enter by registering on line at Yacht Scoring: <a href="http://www.yachtscoring.com">http://www.yachtscoring.com</a> or on approved entry forms received by the Larchmont Yacht Club front desk not later than 1700, Wednesday, July 10, 2013.
- 2.2 The Entry Fee is \$100.00
- 2.3 There will be IRC, Level, One Design and PHRF divisions. At the discretion of the race committee separate divisions for Level and One-Design may be assigned. Divisions may be subdivided into classes.
- 2.4 For those classes not sailing Level or One Design, entries must be accompanied by a valid PHRF, IRC rating certificate. PHRF certificates from other areas will be adjusted to conform to the YRA of LIS. IRC certificates do not need to be endorsed.

## 3 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at least one week before the regatta on the internet at: www.larchmontyc.org and <a href="http://www.yachtscoring.com">http://www.yachtscoring.com</a> or at the Larchmont Yacht Club front desk or the Hospitality Desk on the day of the event.
- 3.2 Scratch Sheets will be available at the front desk after 1800 Friday, July 12, at the Hospitality Desk during the event and, and from the committee boat prior to the first warning signal of the day or on line at Regatta Manager.

## 4 COURSES, RACING AREA AND RACES

- 4.1 The racing area will be south of Milton Point.
- 4.2 The courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions
- 4.3 The warning for the first division will be at 1055 each day.

## 5 SCORING

- 5.1 One completed race constitutes a series.
- 5.2 If fewer than five races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. If five or more races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score subject to rule 90.3 (b).
- 5.3 For PHRF and CRF time allowances will be computed using Time on Distance. For IRC the boats rating allowance will be applied as a factor of the elapsed time.

## 6 PRIZES

Series prizes for First, Second and Third places in each division will be awarded on Sunday, July 21 after the completion of racing on the front lawn of the Larchmont Yacht Club.

## NOTICE OF RACE

## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 1.2 Sections A, B and D of Appendix T will apply as changed
  - (i) Appendix T1 is changed in accordance with YRALIS One –Design sailing instruction 17.
  - (ii) Appendix T2.2 of Section B is changed as follows:
    - (a) 30%, if taken before the protest time limit and before the beginning of arbitration or a protest hearing involving the incident.
    - (b) 40%, if taken before the beginning of a protest hearing involving the incident.

## 2 CLASSES

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following one-design classes: Etchells, IOD, Shields, S-Boat, Ideal 18, 505, and RS K6 or any other one design class that qualifies. To qualify as a class for this regatta, 3 valid entries must be received for that class prior to 1800, Wednesday, July 10.
- A class may elect to race on one weekend instead of the two that are scheduled. On days when a class elects not to race, boats in that class will not get a start, nor will they be scored, provided that the race committee has been previously informed of such class decision.

## 3 ENTRIES

- 3.1 Eligible boats may enter by registering on approved entry forms sent by mail or fax OR online at: <a href="http://www.yachtscoring.com">http://www.yachtscoring.com</a> or <a href="www.larchmontyc.org">www.larchmontyc.org</a> and received at the Larchmont Yacht Club front desk no later than 1200 Friday, July 12, 2013
- 3.2 The entry fee is \$100.00 per boat. For classes electing to race one weekend the entry fee is \$85.00.
- 3.3 All entries not submitted online shall be mailed or faxed to the Larchmont Yacht Club,1 Woodbine Ave., Larchmont, NY 10538. Faxed entries will be accepted only with a valid signature for credit card authorization. Fax: 914-468-7751. All entries must be signed by the owner. Credit card authorizations must be legible and signed by the cardholder.

However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.

- (ii) Appendix T2.2 of Section B is changed as follows:
  - (a) 30%, if taken before the protest time limit and before the beginning of arbitration or a protest hearing involving the incident.
  - (b) 40%, if taken before the beginning of a protest hearing involving the incident.
