# **NOTICE OF RACE**

This is a qualifying regatta for the YRALIS Gitana,
Sappho, Competitors, Kings Point and Allegra Knapp
Mertz Trophies.

# 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Yacht Racing Association of Long Island Sound (YRALIS).

# 2. RULES

- 2.1. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2.2. PHRF entries will be subject to current PHRF regulations as administered by the YRALIS and shall comply with the Minimum Equipment and Safety Recommendations of the YRALIS
- 2.3. Racing rules changed: Rule 44.1 (see NOR 10.1), Rule A2 (see NOR 11.2) and Rules 63 and 64 to permit arbitration.
- 2.4. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 2.5. In the event of a conflict between the NOR and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall govern.

# 3. ADVERTISING

Advertising is permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 and applicable class rules.

# 4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1. All skippers shall be at least Active members of the YRALIS. Membership can be secured by visiting <a href="https://www.yralis.org">www.yralis.org</a>.
- 4.2. This regatta is open to PHRF entries having a rating between -99 and 210 and the following one-design classes: Soverel 33, Etchells, IODs, Shields, RS K6, S-Boats, Vipers, J70s, Ideal 18s, Lasers and Laser Radials. Plus additional one-design classes subject to NOR 4.4 and 4.5.
- 4.3. PHRF entries will be divided in to Windward-Leeward and Navigator classes.4.3.1. The Navigator class may include double-handed, spinnakered and non-spinnakered divisions.
- 4.4. One-design classes interested in participating and not listed in NOR 4.2 should contact the YRALIS (see NOR 13) to request inclusion in the regatta.
- 4.5. A minimum of 5 entries shall be required for any classes not listed in NOR 4.2.
- 4.6. If sufficient interest exists, a Portsmouth Handicap class will be added.

# 5. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEES

- 5.1. Entries for all boats will be accepted via online registration at www.yachtscoring.com.
- 5.2. Entry fees for all boats registered by Wednesday, July 31 are:

- 5.2.1. Single and double-handed classes (Lasers, Ideal 18s, RS K6s) \$50.
- 5.2.2. Three and four person one-designs (Etchells, IODs, Shields, S-Boats, Vipers, J70s) \$70
- 5.2.3. All others including PHRF classes \$130
- 5.3. Entries received after Wednesday, July 31 will be accepted at the discretion of the OA and will be subject to a \$25 late fee.
- 5.4. All entry fees are reduced \$10 if the skipper is a member of US SAILING.
- 5.5. Additional one-design classes not listed in NOR 4.2 will have entry fees consistent with their typical crew sizes and NOR 5.2.

#### 6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. Registration is online only there is no onsite registration.
- 6.2. Each host club will endeavor to run as many races as practical except that any PHRF Navigator class will run only one race per day.
- 6.3. The scheduled time of the warning signal on the RYC circle (see NOR 8) is 1030 each day.
- 6.4. The scheduled time of the first warning on the IHYC and AYC circles is 1230 on Saturday and 1100 on Sunday.
- 6.5. There will be no warning signal after 1500 on Sunday for all classes.
- 6.6. Post-racing parties are at Riverside Yacht Club Saturday and Sunday

#### 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available by Friday, August 2 online at www.yachtscoring.com.

# 8. VENUE

8.1. This is a multi-venue event. Racing will be organized by three clubs (four circles) as described below:

8.2. Classes not listed above will be assigned a venue once they are accepted.

#### 9. THE COURSES

The courses will be windward leeward expect for the PHRF Navigator class which will be irregular and around government marks.

# **10. PENALTY SYSTEM**

10.1. A boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 outside the zone of any rounding or finishing mark, may take a One-Turn Penalty. For a boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 within the zone of any rounding or finishing mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty. This changes rule 44.1.

10.2. The penalty, if any, for a violation of a rule other than a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 will be at discretion of the Protest Committee and may be other than disqualification. This changes rule 64.1(a).

#### 11. SCORING

- 11.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series
- 11.2. When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will the total of her race scores.

# 12. PRIZES

- 12.1. Prizes will be awarded for first and second for classes with up to seven entries and first through third for all others.
- 12.2. Championship prizes will be awarded to the best performing boat on each circle as determined by the OA
- 12.3. The Henry H. Anderson Trophy Single-Handed Championship of Long Island Sound will be awarded to the highest finishing male skipper in the Laser class.
- 12.4. The Commodore Hipkins Trophy Men's Sailing Championship of Long Island Sound will be awarded to the best performing male skipper over the age of 18 from the multi-handed one-design classes racing on the AYC and IHYC circles as determined by the OA.
- 12.5. The Sally Finkbeiner Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the Ideal 18 class.
