1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) rules.
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority: Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May (CYCCM)
- 1.3 RRS 40 will be deleted and replaced with: "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, except briefly while changing clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices." Note that Code Flag "Y" will not be displayed.

2. FLEET ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Laser, Laser Radial and Laser 4.7 competitors who are current members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association may enter by completing registration with the Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May.
- 2.2 Competitors must have a **valid class association ID number**.
- 2.3 All Boats, equipment and, sails must meet Class rules
- 2.4 Sailors must be capable of racing offshore.

3. RISK

- 3.1 Disclaimer of Liability
The races will take place off shore. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk – See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

4. Registration and FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$65 USD, (\$80 after Sunday June 16) Payment may be made by credit card on line at yachtscoring.com
- 4.2 Online Registration is required and available at <https://www.yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=9472> and must be completed by **Wednesday June 19**. No walk in registration will be accepted.

- 4.3 Registered competitors must sign in before close of the Final Registration on Saturday June 22 and turn in a signed waiver. The entry fee includes continental breakfast(s), on the water snacks and water, after race refreshments and Barbecue on Saturday, Sunday Pizza and refreshments, and Awards.
- 4.4 Final Registration will close at 0930 prior to the skipper's meeting.
- 4.6 Tides: JUN 22 High 1228, Low 1806

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 5.1 **Saturday, June 22**
 - 800-0930 Check-In, Final Registration and Continental Breakfast
 - 0945 Skippers Meeting
 - 1030 Harbor Signal
 - 1145 First warning signal, up to 5 races to follow. Refreshments etc. following completion of racing.
- 5.2 **Sunday, June 23**
 - 0830-1000 Continental breakfast
 - 1000 -Harbor signal
 - 1100- Warning signal for upto 4 races
- 5.2a No race shall start after 1600 on Sunday. Awards will follow ASAP after the last race.
- 5.3 Seven (7) races are scheduled, of which a minimum of one (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta. The Race Committee intends to run up to 5 races on Saturday June 22.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, COURSES and VENUE

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available during on-site registration and on Yachtscoring.com. Course configurations will be described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 5.2 Racing will be held in the ocean off Cape May inlet either on the East Course Wildwood, Crest, approximately 1.5 miles ENE of 2CM or the West Course, off Cape May beaches approximately 1 mile West of 2CM. Alternatively, Cape May Harbor may be off utilized if offshore conditions dictate.
- 5.3 Courses will be Windward- Leeward, or Triangles.
- 5.4 Currents going in/ out and the inlet may be unfavorable and require boats to be towed. Skippers are strongly recommended to carry a tow line of approximately 25 feet to attach to club launch tow bridles.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 The Low Point Scoring System for a Regatta, Appendix A2, will be used except as modified below.
- 6.2 There shall be no throw outs

7. AWARDS

- 7.1 All Fleets, First through third place if participation warrants;
