### 2. THE COURSE

The distance of the course is 50.35 NM. The race will be score as **PHRF\_TOT**.

### 3. THE FINISH

3.1. The (NEW) finish mark:

Latitude	42 08.223 N
Longitude	86 30.016 W

Appx. 348° T, 1.25nm from St. Joseph North Pier head Light.

3.2. When approximately one mile from the finish, each boat **shall** notify the race committee on Channel 78. If the race committee does not respond, the hail shall be repeated on three minute intervals until there is a response from race committee. Sail number boards shall be attached to the vessel and be displayed on the Starboard side one half mile prior to finish and 5 minutes after finishing in a position visible to the signal boat. Confirm your finish on Channel 78. Race committee will attempt to have white flashing lights on the mark and yellow flashing lights on the RC signal boat. This changes Sailing Instructions 10.2 and 10.3.

3.3. If the Race Committee Signal boat is not on station at the finish RRS 34 shall be followed. The US Sailing prescription is replaced with the following: If a finishing mark is missing but another one remains in place, the finish line bounded by the remaining mark and a line extending 100 yards at a direction of 160 degrees true from the remaining mark. If the race committee is absent when a boat finishes, she shall: 1. Note her GPS CDT time when she crossed the finish line. (The finish mark will be on station). 2. Notify the race committee, via VHS channel 78, of their finish time, as soon as practicable. 3. A finish report will still be required. This changes Sailing Instructions 10.6.

#### 4. TIME LIMIT

The time limit shall be 1100 CDT on 8/31/2019, plus the amount of any postponement time applicable to a class start. This changes RRS 35. This changes Sailing Instructions 11.

#### 5. SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

Columbia YC will be hosting a volleyball tournament at **Tiscornia Beach** starting at **1400 CDT (1500 EDT)** Saturday 8/31/2019. Be the first at this event to receive a designer COLYC volleyball shirt.

Prizes will be awarded at **(1800 CST) 1900 EST** at St. Joseph River Yacht Club for Volleyball and **1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>** places of all racing sections.

#### 6. Rafting in ST. Joe:

Please do not Raft off any boat slip in the West Basin Marina that is marked with “Caution” tape and a sign stating “No Rafting, you will have to move”. There are slip renters who will be using their boats prior to the departure of the Race Fleet on Sunday morning and their slips will be marked as stated previous.

Rafting is open at the St. Joseph River Yacht Club and the Arboretum on the south side of the channel east of the Railroad Bridge.

#### 7. NAVIGATION:

The area around the pumping stations (cribs) and the marks placed around them by the Coast Guard are hereby designate as an obstruction. Boats shall treat them as such, and not sail between the marks

#### 8. PFD RULE:

Compliant PFDs shall be worn by all crew members while on deck from sunset to sunrise. PFDs shall be worn while on deck during daylight hours unless the Person-in-Charge instructs that they may be removed.

#### 9. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

9.1 RRS Appendix T (Arbitration) will apply. This changes Distance Sailing Instructions, Par 1.
