Addendum I to the Sailing Instructions

The recent Notice to Mariners has indicated that Marks 2, Triumph, and 4, R “4” Turtle, may be missing. A revised edition of the Official Sailing Instructions has been posted indicating the positions of these two marks. If the marks are missing, the positions are points to be observed as if they were marks. As it is not unusual for marks along the course to be missing, unlit or misplaced and it is critical that navigators plot the positions of the marks ahead of time, with offsets for safety, and observe those positions.

7. COURSE

7.1 The course shall be from the starting line South to the **Miami Sea Buoy** (“RW Mo (A) Whistle”), leaving it to starboard; then to the **Key West Sea Buoy** (“RW Mo(A)”) located due South of Key West, leaving the following marks and a continuous line connecting the following marks or points to starboard: If Triumph Light and R “4” are missing, their previous locations as indicated become points to be observed as if they are marks.

**Then, Northward to the Finish Line passing between the channel marker R"14" (Qk FI R)
to Starboard
and G"15" (FL G-4s) to Port.**
