1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) rules.
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority: Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May (CYCCM)
- 1.3 RRS 40 will be deleted and replaced with: "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, except briefly while changing clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices." Note that Code Flag "Y" will not be displayed.
- 1.4 The races will take place off shore and sailors should be experienced for sailing in coastal ocean conditions where current and waves are likely.

2. FLEET ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Laser, Laser Radial competitors who are members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association may enter by completing registration with the Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May. The Regatta is open to competitors regardless of which club or sailing association they are members of, however the MAYRA Champion will be awarded to the highest scoring MAYRA competitors.

3. RISK

- 3.1 Disclaimer of Liability
Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk – See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

4. Registration and FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$45 USD. Payment may be made by credit card on line at yachtscoring.com or by check or cash at Final Registration. Checks should be made payable to "**Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May**".

- 4.2 Online Registration is required and available at www.yachtscoring.com and must be completed by Thursday August 8. No walk in registration will be accepted.
- 4.3 Registered boats must sign in before close of the Final Registration on Sunday 11 and all fees and a signed waiver, must be turned in. The entry fee includes continental breakfast, on the water snacks and water, after race Pizza and refreshments, and Awards.
- 4.4 Adult Beverages after racing are available at the Clubhouse. The cost is NOT included in the entry fee.
- 4.5 Final Registration will close at 0930 prior to the skipper's meeting.
- 4.6 Tides: AUG 11 High 0549, Low 1133

- 5.2 No race shall start after 1600 on Saturday. Awards will follow ASAP after the last race.
- 5.3 Five (5) races are scheduled, of which a minimum of one (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta. The Race Committee intends to run up to 5 races on SUNDAY August 11.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, COURSES and VENUE

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available during on-site registration and on Yachtscoring.com. Course configurations will be described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 5.2 Racing will be held in the ocean off Cape May inlet either on the East Course off Wildwood Crest, approximately 1.5 miles East of 2CM or the West Course off Cape May approximately 1 mile West of 2CM (conditions permitting) Alternatively, Cape May Harbor may be utilized if offshore conditions dictate.
- 5.3 Courses will be Windward Leeward, or Triangles.
- 5.4 Currents going in/ out and the inlet may be unfavorable and require boats to be towed. Skippers are strongly recommended to carry a tow line of approximately 25 feet to attach to club launch tow bridles.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 The Low Point Scoring System for a Regatta, Appendix A2, will be used except as modified below.
- 6.2 There shall be no throw outs.

7. AWARDS

- 7.1 Laser, Laser Radial- First through third place; The MAYRA member in each class with the highest place shall be the MAYRA Champion.

Additional Information:

Cape May is off of Exit 0 on the Garden State Parkway. The CYCCM is located next to the United States Coast Guard Base at 1819 Delaware Avenue. When driving on the Delaware Avenue approach to CYCCM, be careful to observe speed limits and watch for children.

Spectator boats must notify the PRO before the skippers meeting. Spectator Ribs/launches may launch from CYCCM. Spectator boats must be able to be launched from club hoists. There are no on site ramp launching capabilities available. A public boat at the Spicers Creek ramp is nearby. We ask that after launch, you follow mooring and parking directions from CYCCM personnel.
