Amendment #1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Make the following changes to APPENDIX A – Navigator Races

CHANGE A1(a) as follows:

A1 a) The Race Committee will post the course on a white board on the starboard side of the Signal Boat, listing the marks in the order to be rounded and the required side to leave each mark, using the designations on the 2012-2014 South Bay Race Chart or in this Addendum. The Race Committee will also announce the course on the respective fleet VHF channel ~~72~~. Failure to hear this announcement shall not be grounds for redress. This changes rule 62.1(a).

CHANGE A2.1 as follows:

A2.1 The starting mark will be an ORANGE tetrahedron buoy. The finishing mark will be an ORANGE cylinder ~~YELLOW tetrahedron~~ buoy.

CHANGE A3.1 as follows:

A3.1 No more than ~~two~~ four Navigator Races will be run on a given day.

2. Make the following change to APPENDIX B – Stadium Sailing

CHANGE B2.1 as follows:

B2.1 Marks will be inflatable ~~tetrahedron~~ buoys as follows:

<u>Original marks</u>	<u>Starting</u>	<u>Finishing</u>	<u>Change marks</u>
Yellow <u>tetrahedron</u>	Orange <u>tetrahedron</u>	Yellow <u>Orange cylinder</u>	Orange <u>tetrahedron</u>

3. Make the following change to APPENDIX C – Drop Mark Races

CHANGE C2.1 as follows:

C2 MARKS FOR DROP MARK COURSES

C2.1 Marks will be inflatable tetrahedron buoys as follows:

<u>Fleet</u>	<u>Original marks</u>	<u>Starting</u>	<u>Finishing</u>	<u>Change marks</u>
WHITE	Yellow	Orange	Yellow <u>Green</u>	Orange
BLUE	Orange	Yellow	Orange <u>Pink</u>	Yellow

4. Make the following change to APPENDIX D – Distance Race


UPDATE the following mark descriptions in D2.2 as follows:

D2.2 The following are the designations for the rounding marks that might be used:

H	RW “NB” Mo(A) WHIS	41° <u>23.00</u> ’ N; 071° 23.36’ W
J	R “2” Fl R 4s WHIS south of Point Judith	41° 18. <u>46</u> ’ N; 071° 28.35’ W
K	R N “2NS” Nebraska Shoal	41° <u>20.98</u> ’ N; 071° 34.50’ W
L	G “1 BI” Fl G 4s BELL north of Block I	41° 15. <u>49</u> ’ N; 071° 34. <u>55</u> ’ W
M	Block Island including Black Rock Pt. Buoy 2	41° 08.42’ N; 071° 35.74’ W (<u>round in either direction</u>)
N	GR “NR” BELL off Beavertail	41° 26.64’ N, 071° 24. <u>15</u> ’ W
P	R “6” BELL off Castle Hill	41° 27. <u>44</u> ’ N, 071° 21.98’ W
Q	Buzzards Light Tower Fl 2.5s 67ft 17M Horn	41° 23. <u>82</u> ’ N, 071° 02. <u>08</u> ’ W

CHANGE D3(a) as follows:

- a) The Race Committee will post the course on a white board on the starboard side of the Signal Boat, listing the marks in the order to be rounded, and the required side to leave each mark. If designated, Mark M, Block Island and Black Rock Pt. Buoy 2, may be rounded in either direction and a required side will not be listed. If the Race Committee plans to post a different course for a subsequent class, they will signal a postponement and post the new course. The Race Committee will also announce the course on the fleet VHF channel. Failure to hear this announcement shall not be grounds for redress. This changes rule 62.1(a).
